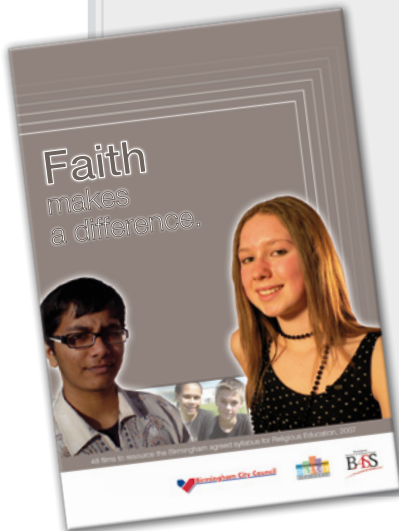

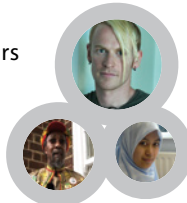

- is equally suitable from KS2 to KS4. Each disposition has two films, one at initial level featuring younger children and one at advanced level designed for KS3 and above
- links to a web site with further detailed descriptions, quotes from participants and sample lesson plans
- contains a wealth of starting points for learners working independently and teachers using the films with all classes
- contains CPD training films for teachers who are unfamiliar with using dispositions as a starting point for lessons.
